General regulations for all categories and instruments

REGISTRATION

Candidates are requested to fill in the official **entry-form** only [online](http://www.harmonikaverband.at) at www.harmonikaverband.at !

ENTRY FEE per category

SOLOISTS	€ 26,--
DUOS, CHAMBERMUSIK	€ 12,- per player
ENSEMBLES UND ORCHESTRAS	€ 7,- per player

The entry form and the fee are considered to be one unit which means that the registration fee has to be paid till 6th May 2022 to be accepted for the competition.

Candidates from countries with other currency than Euro are allowed to pay the entry fee on arrival by presenting the written agreement of the office.

ADMISSION

The time of playing will be announced 2 weeks before the competition on the HVÖ-Homepage www.harmonikaverband.at.

PLEASE SHOW YOUR PASSPORT, to have the possibility of age control !

Please note:

A younger player may compete in a higher rating class, but must then play all pieces in this level of difficulty!

JURY

Contestants are judged in all sections on overall musicianship, including technical proficiency, stylistic understanding and the artistic impression of all music performed.

THE DECISIONS OF THE JURY ARE FINAL!

The jury is allowed to interrupt the candidate's performance in case of ignoring the time limit as set up.

The candidate accepts by signature any recordings of his/her performance, made by the jury, to support the judgement. The reporting candidate may be filmed only by a person who is instructed by him/her.

MUSIC

Two (2) copies plus the original of his/her music needs to be handed over to the jury. The original will be returned afterwards.

PERFORMANCE TIME

The specified maximum playing time includes performance, short break between pieces and exit!

AWARD WINNERS AND DOCUMENTS

The first three winners will be determined in each competition class. They receive cups. Every participant, every group, every orchestra receives a certificate.

The following predicates are provided:

- **Outstanding** 46-50 Points
(Only Accordion-Junior Master / Master and Styrian D, E and Duo C)
- **Excellent** 40-50
- **Very good** 26-39
- **Good** till 25

If there are fewer than 3 candidates in a category, only distinctions will be awarded!
The certificates are only issued at the award ceremony!

PRICEGIVING

The award ceremonies will take place as part of the award winners' concerts.

Candidates have **free entries** to all contests and prize giving ceremony!
