GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR ALL CATEGORIES

The Competition takes place at: TERME OLIMIA, SI 3254 Podčetrtek, Slowenien

Friday/Saturday, 27/28 May 2022

1. The 12th INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR DIATONIC (Styrian) ACCORDION (WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP) is advertised for soloists of all nationalities and sex. An unlimited number of participants are possible.

The event is signed out in the following categories:

Diatonic Accordion – Soloists (Styrian model): **Juniors (born 2003 – 2009)**

World Champion Class (born 1990 - 2002)

To the registration of a junior a copy of the birth certificate needs to be enclosed

- 2. The 1st prize winner of the junior class must line up with the next competition in the world champion's class. The winner of the world champion's class can line up only again with the next but one competition.

The entry form and the fee are considered to be one unit which means that the registration fee has to be paid till 6th May 2022 to be accepted for the competition.

Candidates from countries with other currency than Euro are allowed to pay the entry fee on arrival by presenting the written agreement of the office.

5. A candidate's entry also implies acceptance of regulation, the system of judging and jury's decision as being final. Two (2) copies plus the original of his/her music needs to be handed over to the jury. The original will be returned afterwards.

There is NO restriction referring to the make of diatonic-accordions used.

Electronical support is not allowed!

6. SPECIAL REGULATIONS:

- a) The program played must be 3 pieces with max. 12 minutes playing time (juniors) or 4 pieces with max. 15 minutes of playing time (adults) included.
- b) 2 pieces must have traditional character or come from the country of the World Cup participant (these pieces do not have to be written original for the Styrian/Diatonic harmonica, but they have to be interpreted correctly in terms of style).
- c) If non-traditional pieces are played, only compositions are allowed that are original compositions for the Styrian/Diatonic harmonica!
- d) 1 (juniors) or 2 pieces (adults) can express other styles (characteristics), eg. Jazz, Blues, Latino, Rock'n Roll, Swing, Classical etc.
- e) These must be original compositions for the Styrian/Diatonic harmonica.

Note: Johann Strauss, Piazzolla, Monti etc. did not compose for the Styrian or Diatonic!

- f) Arrangements and Potpourri's are absolutely NOT ALLOWED!
- fg The program should be diversified.
- h) The program composition is part of the judging
- i) Non-compliance with the rules will be punished with point deductions!

7. THE CANDIDATE HAS TO PERFORM BY MEMORY!

The candidate must:

- a) take down the composer's full name
- b) give the exact time of performance of each piece selected
- c) play the announced program changes are not permitted
- d) confirm by sending the online form that she/he has understood the rules and agreed to them

8. DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY:

From the juniors and senior citizens to played pieces must correspond at least in the HVÖ list of books for step D to classified ones, pieces for the adults (world champion class) to those of the step E! See >>>> www.harmonikaverband.at

9. **JUDGING**:

Contestants are judged in all sections on overall musicianship, including technical profiency, stylistic understanding and the artistic impression of all music performed.

THE DECISIONS OF THE JURY ARE FINAL!

The jury is allowed to interrupt the candidate's performance in case of ignoring the time limit as set up.

- 10. The candidate accepts by signature any recordings of his/her performance, made by the jury, to support the judgement. The reporting candidate may be filmed only by a person who is instructed by him/her.
